

## Community Mapping

It may be helpful to map which streets have been contacted in your area, to discover which areas have been missed. You could use this to help organise or share them online with links and contacts.

There are a number of sites where you can set up free maps. Here is one made for Rodborough:

**How to do this** (see screenshot below)

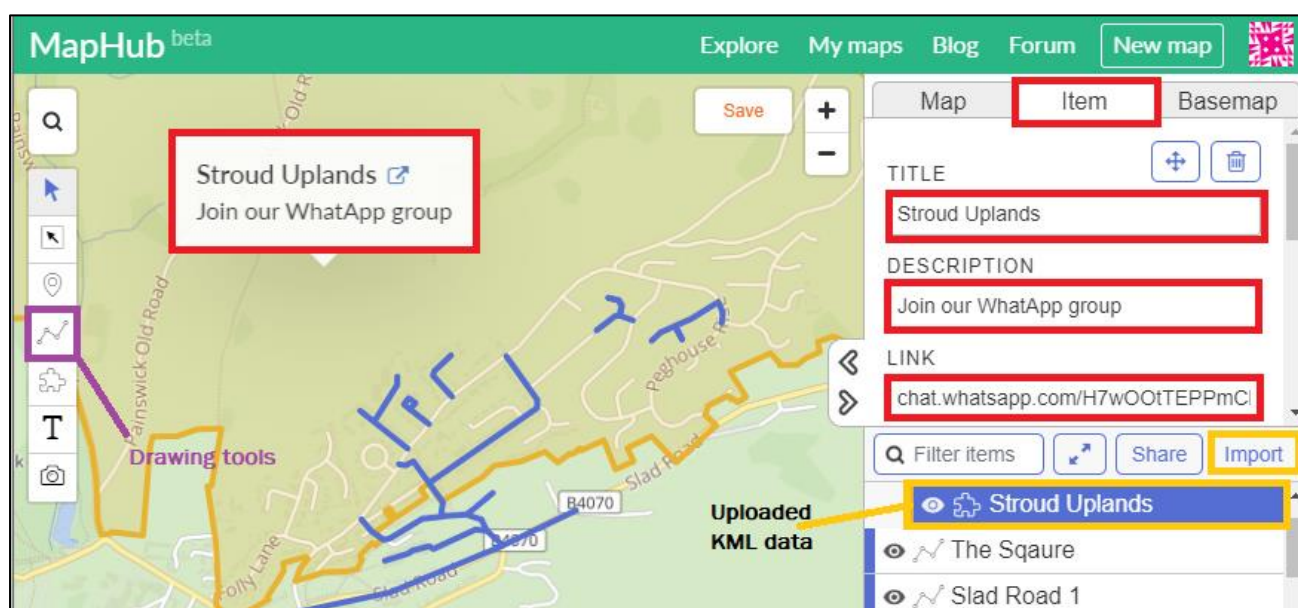
1. Join MapHub ([maphub.net](http://maphub.net)) and create New Map
2. Zoom into the Stroud area
3. Draw on the areas you have contacted

### Extra features

You might also add an 'overlay' of the ward, parish or postcode. The data for this is freely available following this link below. You can download the KML files and then upload them to MapHub.
